DOG FRIENDLY AREA RULES AND REGULATIONS

HOURS: SUNRISE TO SUNSET

Ordinance 0-14-07 was established for this facility for the purpose of allowing off leash exercise of dogs, provided that such dog(s) are under the control of a handler who is competent and knowledgeable relative to the behavior of such said dog(s).

- Dog area participation is at your own risk.
- Entry to Dog Area is restricted to persons who have obtained a permit from the Park District. Owners must display the pass/ permit at all times and relinquish upon request by Park District personnel. Dog owners not complying will be subject to fines of up to \$1,000.00. Periodic surveillance will be conducted by Park District Employees and the Wood Dale Police Department. Permits may be purchased at The Recreation Complex, 111 E. Foster Ave.
- Children under 12 years old are not allowed in the dog area, those between 12 and 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
- Dog(s) must be under the (visual & voice) control of their handler, at least 18 years old, at all times.
- Handler must immediately remove dog(s) when they become agitated, engaged in excessive barking or are fighting with other dog(s).
- Handler must have in his/her possession a leash at all times. Dogs must be wearing a collar. Dogs outside the fenced area must be leashed.
- Dog(s) must be free of contagious or infectious diseases, parasite free and have no visible wounds or injuries. Female dogs in heat are not permitted.
- Cover any holes your dog digs.
- You are solely responsible for the actions of your dog. Upon entrance to White Oaks Park you assume the full risk of any injuries, damage or loss connected with or associated with the use of the Dog Area.
- No more than two dogs per person during visit.
- You must leash and remove your dog immediately if aggressive behavior is observed.
- Dogs with repeated incidents of aggressiveness may be banned.
- Alcohol, food (including dog food, biscuits or treats), glass bottles and smoking is prohibited.
- No dogs under the age of four months or female dogs in heat are permitted in the dog area.
- Collars must be worn always. No pinch or spike collars allowed.
- You must pick up and dispose any waste generated by your dog; bags are provided.
- Violators of any ordinance provisions are subject to fines, removal from the facility and may be prohibited from future use of the dog area.
