White Oak Dog Park Rules & Regulations

Ordinance 0-14-07 was established for this facility for the purpose of allowing the off-leash exercise of dogs, provided that such dog(s) are under the control of a handler who is competent and knowledgeable relative to the behavior of said dog(s).

- Use of the facility shall be at the users' own risk
- No more than two (2) dogs per user are allowed in the Dog Park
- Children under 12 years old are not allowed in the Dog Park, those between 12 and 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult
- Dog(s) must be under the (visual & voice) control of their handler, at least 18 years old, at all times while at or inside the facility.
- Handler must have in his/her possession a leash at all times. Dogs must be wearing a collar. Dogs outside facility must be leashed.
- Handler must ensure their Dog(s) are at least 4 months old, legally licensed and their vaccinations are up to date. Current license tags must be displayed on the dog's collar.
- Dog(s) must be free of contagious or infectious diseases, parasite free and have no visible wounds or injuries. Female dogs in heat are not permitted to use the facility.
- Any holes dug by dog(s) must be filled by handler
- Handler must immediately remove dog(s) when they become agitated, engaged in excessive barking or are fighting with other dogs
- Dog(s) handler using the facility must use a suitable container to promptly remove any feces deposited by their dogs
- Dogs deemed to be vicious, or who have a previous history of aggressive behavior toward other animals or humans are not permitted to enter the facility
- Alcohol, food (including dog food, biscuits or/treats), glass bottles and smoking is prohibited
- The use of bicycles, roller blades/skates, skateboards, motorized vehicles (except for use by the disabled) are prohibited
- Violators of any ordinance provisions are subject to fines, removal from the facility and may be prohibited from future use of the Dog Park
- In the event of an emergency call 911
